## INVOLVEMENT

In 2019, volunteers donated 4,279 hours of service through VolunteerMPC, a responsive website allowing individuals to find volunteer projects that fit their passion.

## EFFICIENCY

United Way MPC has received Charity Navigator's 3-Star Rating and the Guide Star Silver certification. The administrative rate of 12.2% is significantly lower than the average of 35% recommended by the Charities Review Council.

## RESULTS

United Way and its funded partners are working to address the needs in the three impact areas of Health, Education, and Financial Stability.

- About 20,649 weekend food packs were sent home to school children in 2019
- A total of 1,633 individuals received job training and employment assistance.
- More than 3,000 people received substance abuse, mental health counseling and support services.

The Family Resource Network program coordinates the Monongalia Food and Hunger Committee, consisting of the 11 food pantries in Monongalia County. In 2019, 62,748 pounds of food were donated to food pantries serving on the Mon County Food and Hunger Committee.

Funding supports 43 programs at 24 health and human service agencies in Monongalia and Preston counties.

## RESOURCES

United Way MPC generated \$1.4 million through its annual campaign in 2019. An additional \$400,000 was generated in grants and sponsorships and other revenue, resulting in total resources of \$1.8 million. Non-financial contributions in the form of in-kind gifts are valued at over \$150,000.
