<p>Christian Help - Colleen Lankford</p>	<p>Serves all people. No qualifying criteria. Free Store shopping 1x/rolling week; Pantry support 1x/rolling 30 days; Career Closet items 1x/month; and financial assistance to annual maximum. Year-round vocational help, life skill classes, and gifting programs.</p>
<p>Healthy Kids Inc./Project Healthy Kids - Mandy Curry, Mary Hastings</p>	<p>Provides services to childcare centers, private schools, recovery centers, and medically tailored meal production daily, M-F, to 4 counties. No qualifications or guidelines. Has both frozen and hot meals for summer programs.</p>
<p>The Pantry Plus More - Amanda Bolyard & Emily Pertl</p>	<p>Serves pre-K-12 and their families, Mon Co. residents through MFB distribution. Food, hygiene, ETC available every day at school, Saturday distribution 2x a month. No qualifications or guidelines. Summer programs include Saturday distribution continues during the summer months.</p>

Baby and Toddler program is open Monday through Thursday except for the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month because of pantry days.

Food and limited hygiene item pantry located at 4120 Fairmont Rd in the Arnettsville Community Center, open hours on Wednesdays from 12:30pm to 3:00pm, and by appointment other weekdays. Available to all individuals and families in need of food with no income requirements. Also offers referrals for free spay/neuter for dogs and cats. No specific summer programs.
